INTRODUCTION

Dear friend.

On behalf of the Spanish Cooperative Group for the Treatment of Digestive Tumors (TTD), we are pleased to invite you to attend the 29th International Symposium of our group, which will take place in Madrid on the 16th and 17th of December this year.

As you know, this is a reference congress, which has become a meeting point for leading specialists, both national and international, who will share their experience and present the latest data related to the progress in the investigation of the digestive tumors.

The program includes six round tables focused on the first day, on gastro-esophageal cancer, liver tumors and pancreatic tumors; the latter will feature a debate on Adjuvant vs Neoadjuvant in resectable pancreatic cancer. We will end the first day with a round table on new approaches in digestive tumor pathology. The second day will be dedicated to colorectal cancer, where, in addition to addressing the localized disease and molecular characterization, and metastatic disease, we have included a controversy on how the indication of adjuvant chemotherapy in stage II colon cancer is influenced by the new ESMO classification and the ctDNA determination. The program also includes a keynote lecture with a topical issue on the clinical and molecular profile of colorectal cancer in young people.

As usual in our events, the clinical cases will again be presented in poster format in what has become the 9th edition of the competition, which allows specialists to contribute their experiences and exchange knowledge among all of them. Additionally, two grants will be awarded to research projects in digestive tumors, in their second edition.

We pin all our hopes on being able to meet again you again in person in Madrid and have your active participation.


