INTRODUCTION

Dear friend,

On behalf of the Spanish Cooperative Group for the Treatment of Digestive Tumors (TTD Group), and on behalf of the Scientific and Organizing Committee of the congress, I am pleased to invite you to the 30th International Symposium "Advances in the Treatment of Digestive Tumors" that will take place in Santander, on December 15th and 16th. It is important to note that this year the Organizing Committee is composed of several representatives from the north of the peninsula (Galicia, Asturias, Navarra and Cantabria) and the wish of all of us is that one more year the event will be a meeting point and reference for all those oncologist specialists and other professionals involved in the research and treatment of digestive tumors.

We will have the participation of leading national and international specialists and we are sure that they will meet the expectations we place on them. The program contains a table dedicated to pancreatic tumors and NET, another to gastro-esophageal cancer, and another to liver tumors (including liver metastases, hepatocarcinomas and cholangiocarcinomas). The fourth table will be dedicated to a very current topic, the application of new information technologies and artificial intelligence in digestive cancer and future expectations. The last two tables will be dedicated to colorectal cancer: the first one will address the epidermoid carcinoma of the anal canal, peritoneal disease, and includes a controversy about the role of "watch and wait" in localized rectal cancer, and the last one will be dedicated to the metastatic CRC.

As in previous editions, the clinical cases that compete in what is already the 10th edition of the Contest, will be presented in poster format, which allows the contribution of experiences of specialists and the exchange of knowledge among all professionals. It will also proceed to the delivery of aid to research projects in digestive tumors that celebrates its third edition.

Thank you very much in advance for your attendance, and we hope that we will spend a few days of work and exchange of ideas and opinions that produce the best fruits.

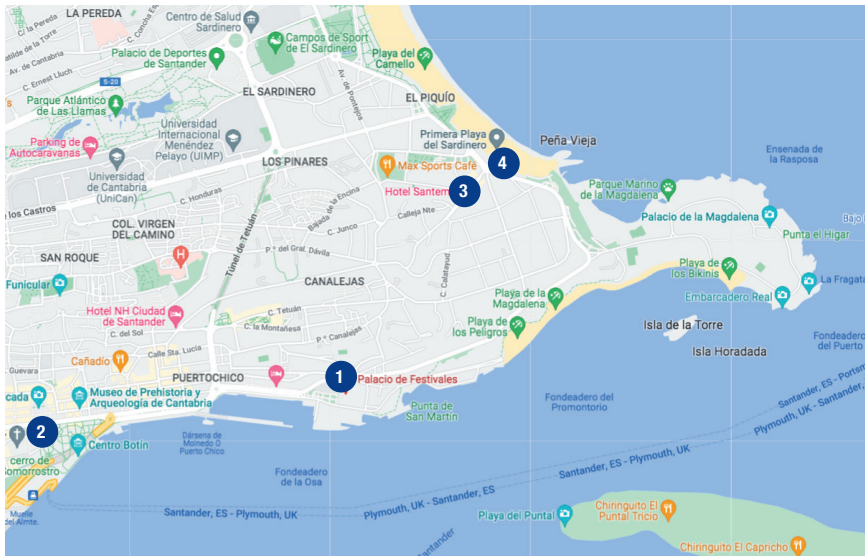

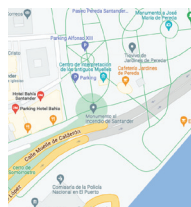
